(h) No dumping of waste, rubbish, junk or debrls shall be allowed in any area within twenty-five (25) feet of the nearest point of the base of the tower's poles, supports or other structure of any public utility company, it agents, successors, or assignes.

(j) Any person, firm, or corporation dumping shall do so at his, its, or their own risk and the Township of Hancock shall not be held flable for any injurels or demages occuring therein.

(i) No township operated dump shall be used for any purpose other than for dumping operations permitted under this ordinance. No picking or scavenging of any township operated dump shall be permitted by any person, firm, or corporation other than those duly so licensed, registered with and approved by the Hancock Township Board. No loitering shall be allowed within a township operated dump and no person, firm, or corporation using such dumping facilities shall interfere with the rights, duties, and privileges of any other person, firm, or corporation using such dumping facilities in accordance with the rowisions of this ordinance.

(k) No garbage nor oderiferous material shall be burned in any area withto such bank. (h) No dumping of waste, rubbish, junk or debris shall be allowed in any THE Atto the provisions of this ordinance.

(k) No garbage nor oderiferous material shall be burned in any area within Hancock township without the prior written approval of the supervisor and fire chief of said township to be granted only in cases where the same could not be a inulsance to, or unsafe for surrounding apposities, property owners. rounding properties, property owners, and neighbors.

(1) The Township of Hancock shall not be liable for any damage to property adjoining a township operated dump caused by fires within said dump not approved in writing by the supervisor and fire chief of said township.

3. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS. Any person, firm, or corporation which violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment in the county lail, not to exceed ten (10) days, or fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation occurs shall constitute a seperate offense.

LEGAL ADVERTISEMENT April 14, 1967 STAE OF MICHIGAN Ordinance Number 2 An Ordinance granting to secure the public peace, health, safety, welfare and convenience of the residents and property owners of the Township of Hancock, Houghton County, Michigan, by the regulation of dumping grounds for waste, rubbish, Junk and debris, and the operation thereof within said township; to provide penalties for the violations thereof; and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith. The Township of Hancock, County of Houghton, State of Michigan ordains, 1. NAME. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Hancock Township DUMPING Ground Ordinance, 2. REGULATONS. (a) No person, firm or corporation shall dump any waste, rubbish, Junk or debris in any area of the Township of Hancock, Houghton County, unless the same is zoned to permit such use of property under the Hancock Township Zoning Ordinance, or unless the same is maintained and operated for such dumping ground purposes or a permit is obtained therefor from the township board, to be granted only in situations where such dumping would not be a nuisance or annoyance to adjoining property owners.
